Graduate employment

If you are currently a student at an Australian university, there is no doubt where you should start your internet job search—at your own University’s careers and graduate employment website. These websites for all Australian universities are listed in this chapter. Most of them contain up-to-date information about who is recruiting graduates right now from that campus, and will also usually contain links to the most useful general sites, such as are listed elsewhere in this book. They will also usually link you to the sites of major graduate employers seeking online applications.

Of course, this is only one aspect of the kinds of services provided by the campus careers offices, and their websites will lead you to the range of services available. If you are a less recent graduate of one of the universities below, you might find some useful information at these sites, though the actual vacancy information listed is usually geared to new or very recent graduates.

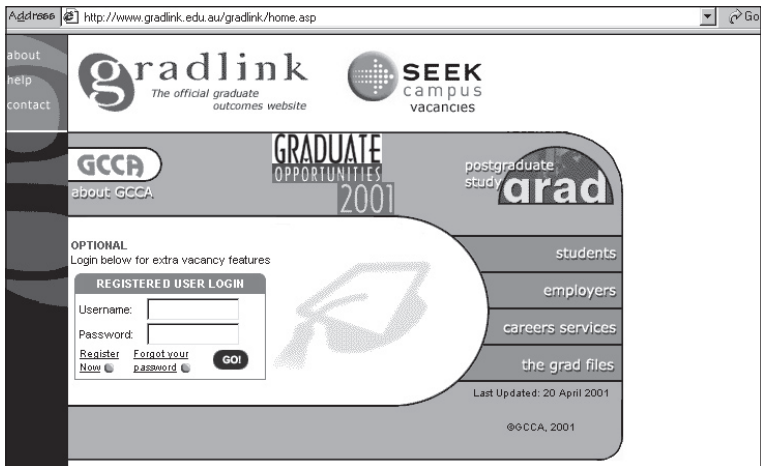
If you are a student at or a graduate of a university outside Australia, you might also find some of these sites useful in guiding you to major recruiters of graduates (see also Chapter 11).

Gradlink

Amongst other sites which deal with graduate employment, the pre-eminent one is the official graduate employment site for the higher education system as a whole, Gradlink, which is found at:

Gradlink is the site of the Graduate Careers Council of Australia, and contains extremely useful information about the graduate labour market, about major employers of graduates, postgraduate study, and university careers services.

This site plugs into SEEK's national vacancy systems, and has job search facilities, a resource centre, and a wide range of information relevant to students and graduates.

Other sites for graduates

All of the following sites carry graduate vacancies, and most have links with a number of graduate recruiters, on whose behalf they carry out at least the first stage of graduate recruitment—in some cases this extends to a comprehensive application and selection process. None of these sites covers the whole ground, i.e. none has an absolutely comprehensive coverage of major graduate recruiters. That is more likely to come initially from the university careers service sites.

This site was begun by young graduates for new graduates and employers. It provides a comprehensive application process for positions with those employers who have joined up. In early 2001,

NGA formed an alliance with the much larger www.mycareer.com.au, which will lead to the disappearance of this site for job-seeking purposes. It will be absorbed into the Graduate page of Mycareer.

This a relative newcomer amongst specialist graduate sites. It plugs into the general careerone resources, as well as having some specialist material for new graduates.
